TRANSFERS LOADED ON BREEZE CARD OR TICKET

Effective September 1, 2007 all customers will be required to have a valid Breeze Card/Ticket loaded with appropriate fare to ride MARTA. Bus to bus transfers will no longer be issued. Transfers will only be available on a Breeze Card or Ticket and are automatically loaded



when you tap to board a bus or exit a rail station. If you pay with cash you will still need a Breeze Card/Ticket to receive your transfer.

Breeze Cards/Tickets are available for purchase from the Breeze Vending Machines at all of our 38 stations or MARTA RideStores. New Breeze Cards cost \$5 which includes two free trips in addition to whatever fare you load. New Breeze Tickets cost \$0.50 cents in addition to the fare.

BIKES ON MARTA

Wish you could ride your bike to work? You can using MARTA! Bikes are allowed on all MARTA trains and buses.

Taking your bike on MARTA is easy... simply:



- Avoid boarding trains that are full
- Keep bike out of the aisle and away from the train door
- Use elevators when taking bikes in and out of rail stations
- Place bikes on racks on front of bus

MARTA: THE "GREEN" WAY TO GO

MARTA does more than take Atlantans where they need to go, it makes our lives better in the process.

Between 2000 and 2005, 56,000 new people moved within walking distance (4/10 miles) of transit. Another 86,000 residents took jobs within the same distance of transit.

MARTA plays a big role in preserving Atlanta's quality of life by reducing air pollution and traffic congestion. Daily, MARTA reduces air pollutants by removing 185,000 cars from Atlanta roads.
